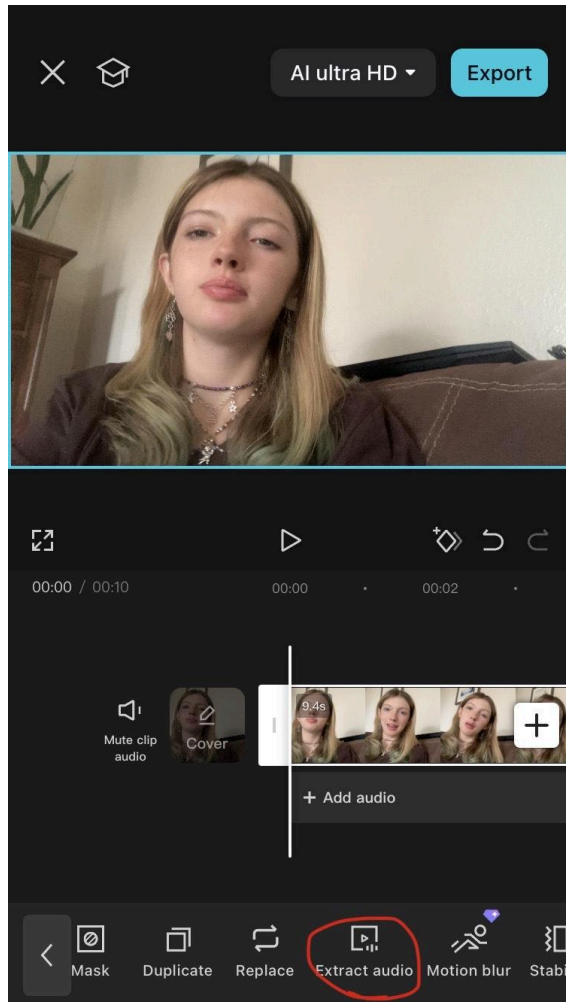


How to fix audio issues in CapCut (mobile)

After recording and importing your audio into CapCut to edit it, you may notice issues such as too much background noise or a delay. But, luckily, there are solutions.

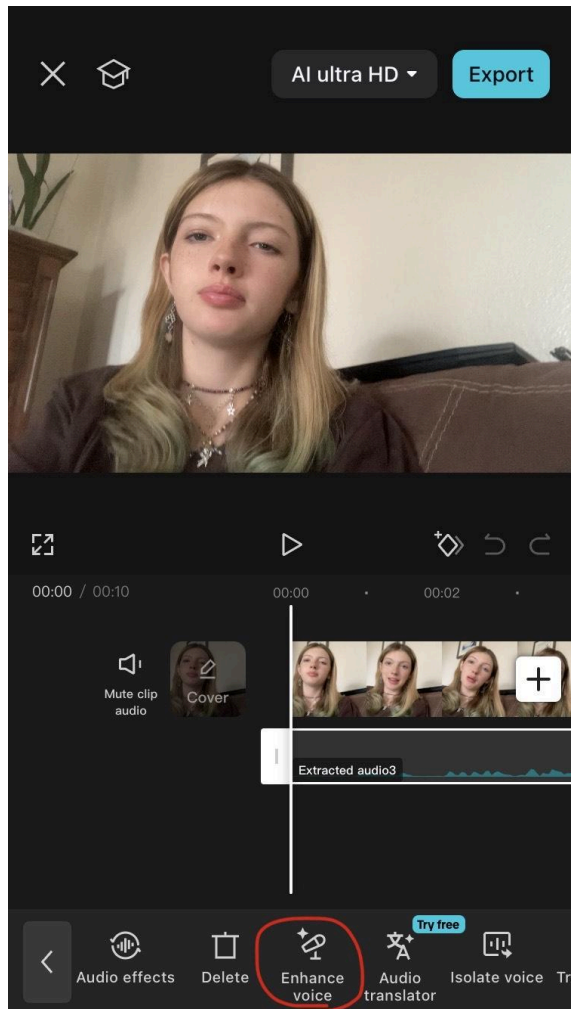
For a sound delay what you can do is select the clip > Extract Audio.



Then trip out the mess up part of your audio and realign it to match your video.

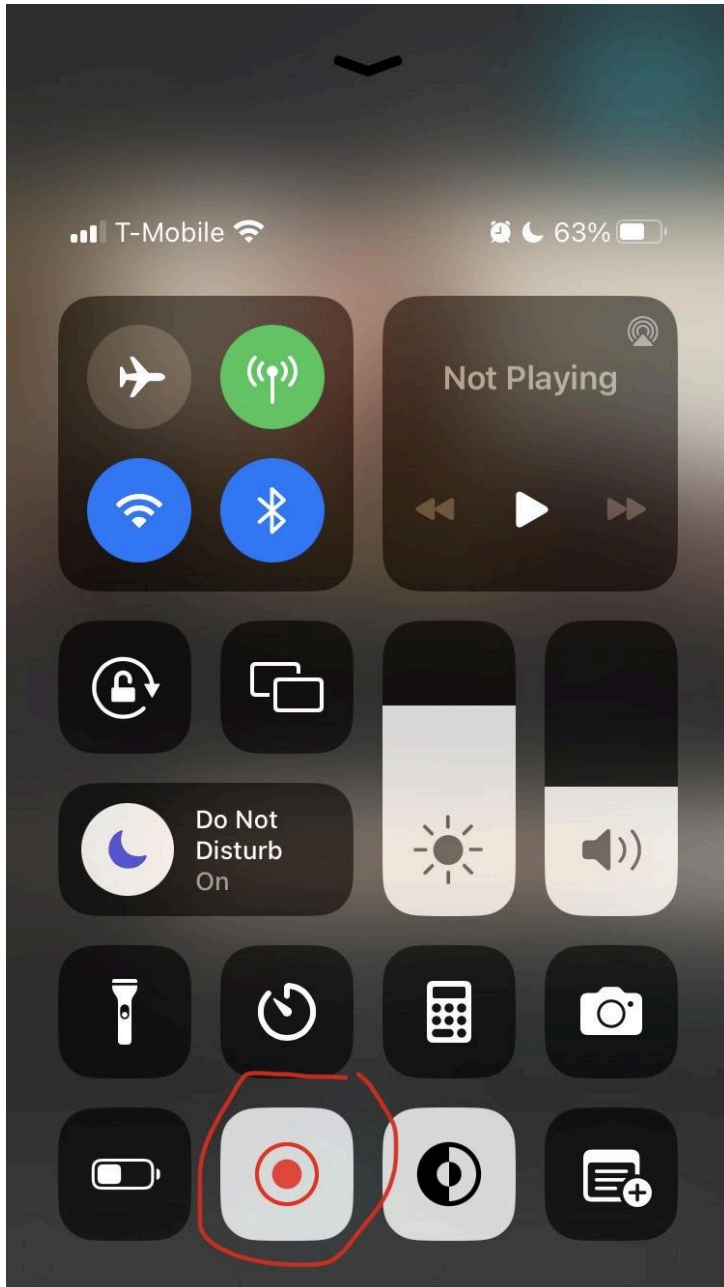
For Too much background noise select the clip > Extract Audio.

Take the audio clip and use Enhance voice.

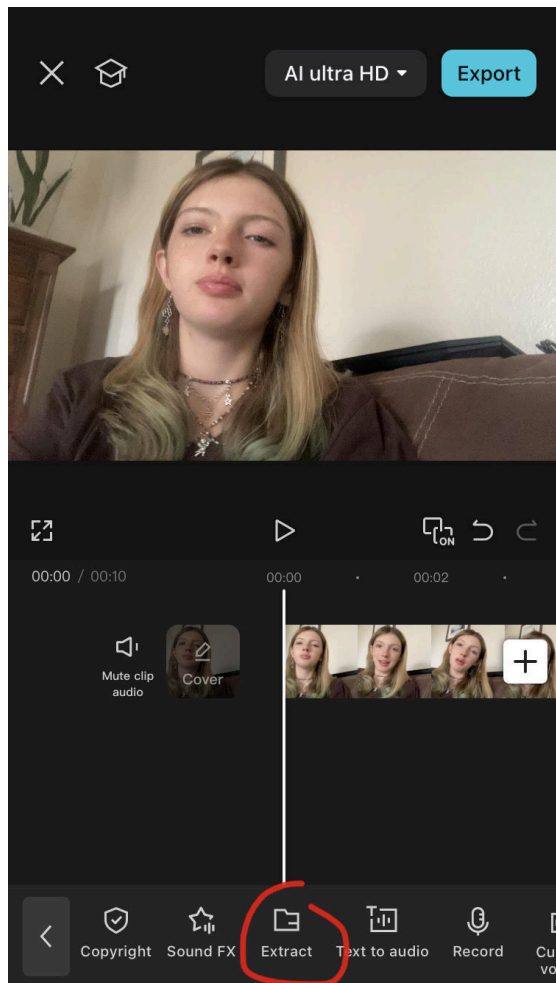


However this feature is a premium feature, but here's a way to get around it.

Screen record the whole audio clip.



Go to audio > Extract > click your new screen recording



Trim it to fit and realign it.

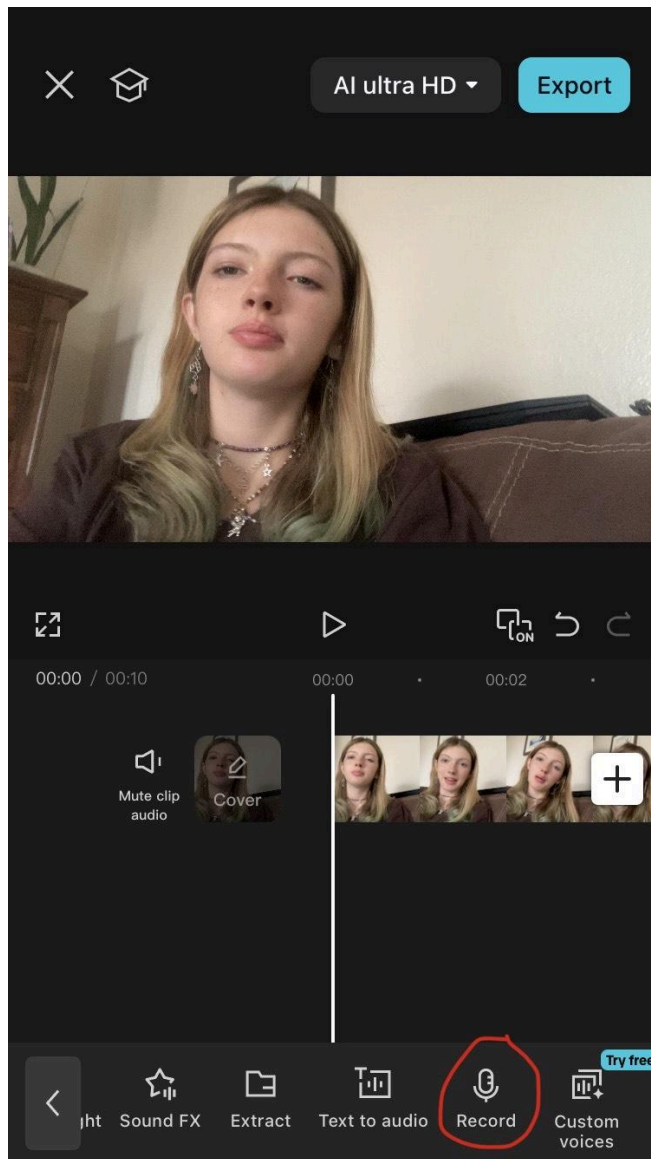
