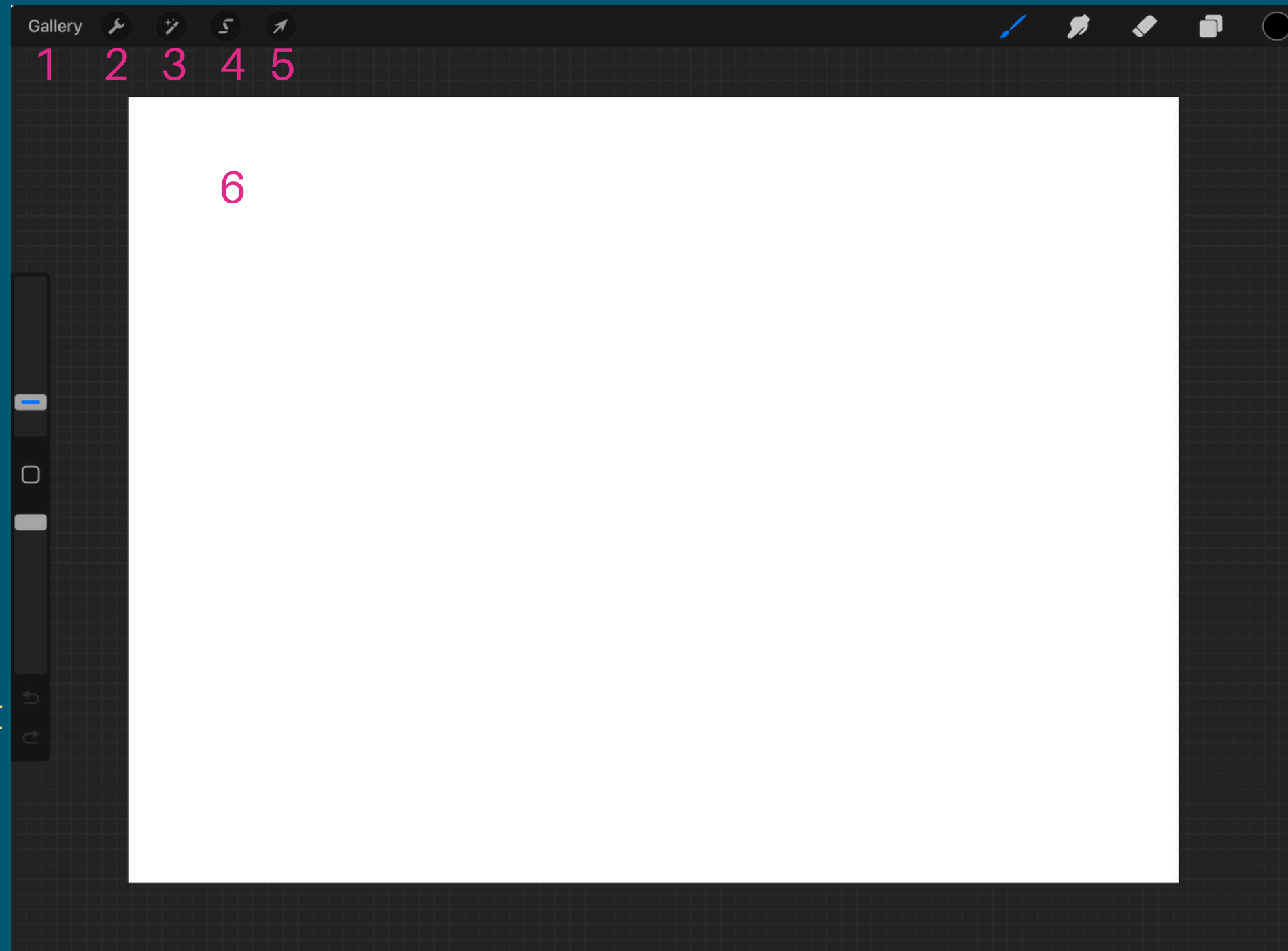
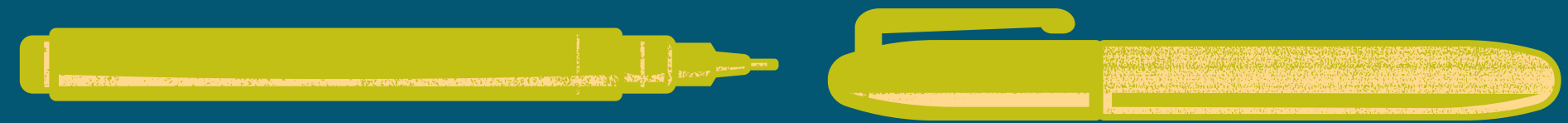

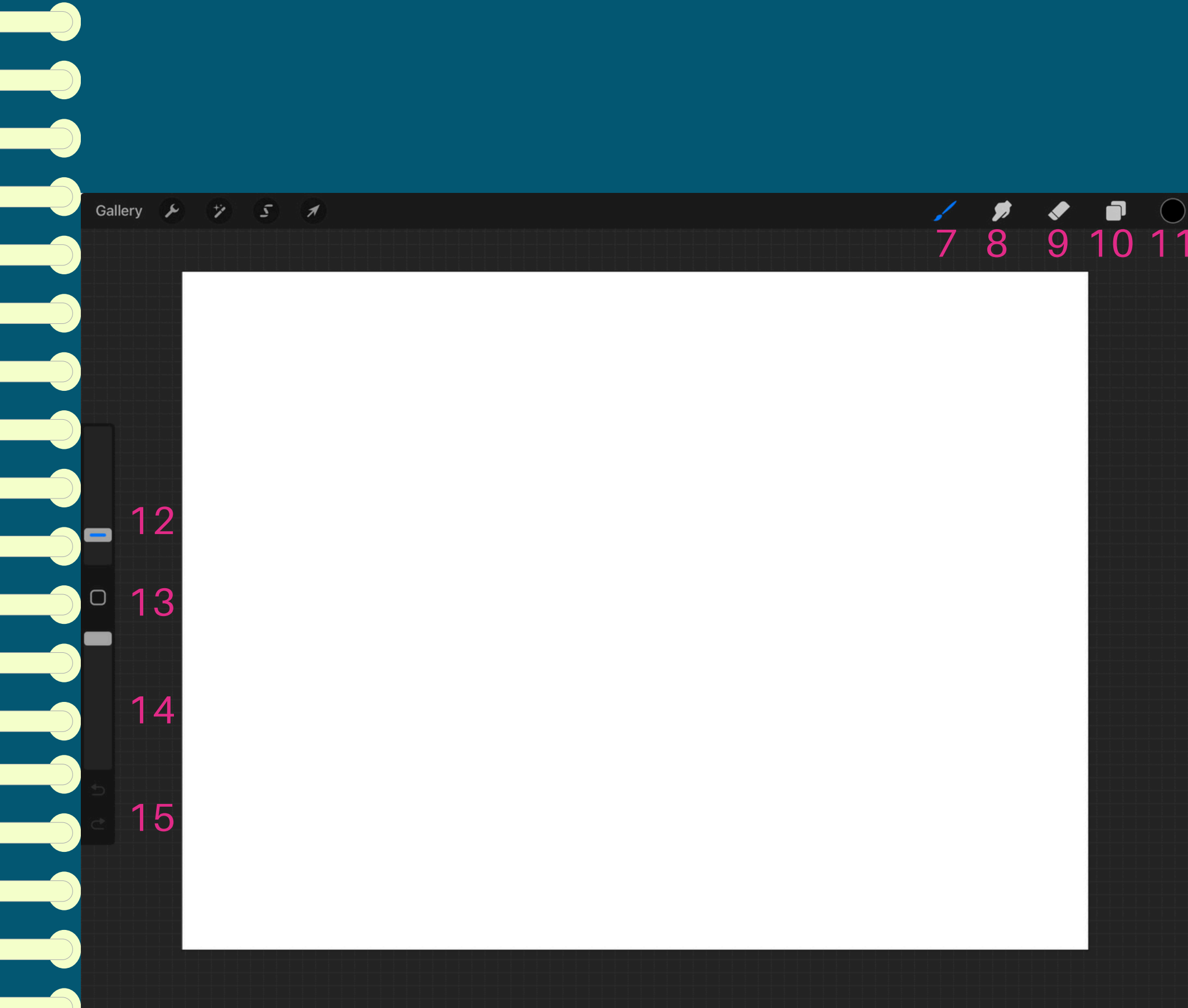


BASIC TOOLS

PROCREATE IS AN
ILLUSTRATION PROGRAM,
BUT IT IS SO MUCH MORE!



1. Pressing one will take you back to your gallery of artwork and past works.
2. This is the actions bar. From here you can achieve numerous places to share, edit, and import to your canvas. You can also access your interface preferences.
3. This is the adjustments panel. Here you can do any kind of color or effects adjustment.
4. This is the selection tool. You can use it to select pixels via ellipse, rectangle, and auto select
5. This is the transform tool, used to scale, warp, dilate and transform selected pixels.
6. This is the canvas. Based in pixels and crop-able through the actions menu.



7. This is the brush toolbar. By selecting it you can scroll through the archive of standard brushes procreate provides, or import your own!

8. The smudge tool is exactly the same as your brush selection, but will shift around the pixels rather than add to them.

9. The eraser functions the same as the smudge and brush, but erases pixels rather than creates or changes them.

10. This is the layers panel. You can use it to draw above or below elements of your drawing.

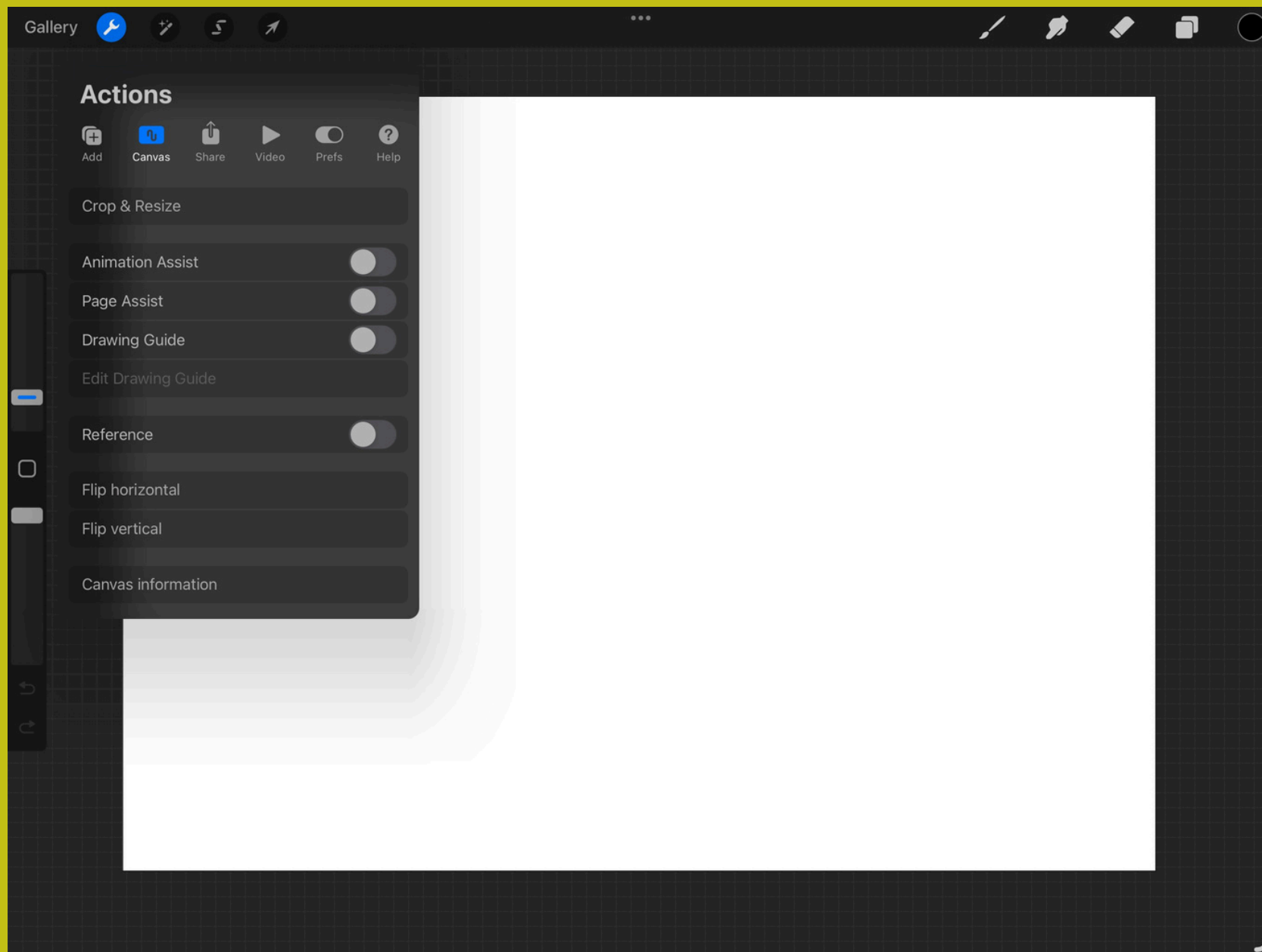
11. This is the color wheel, used to select the color of your brush.

12. The top bar is used to change the scale of your brush (bigger, smaller)

13. This is the modify icon, and can be personalized to do specific actions in the preferences menu

14. This bar can be used to adjust the transparency or opacity of your brush

15. To undo or redo an action press these.



Action Toolbar

BASICALLY IT HAS

If you're looking to place an image, import a file, or add text, you can do so through the add tab of the actions bar. By swiping right on the icon, you can make the imported document invisible from the document timelapse.

From the canvas section of the toolbar, you can change your canvas size, and enable two canvas functions:

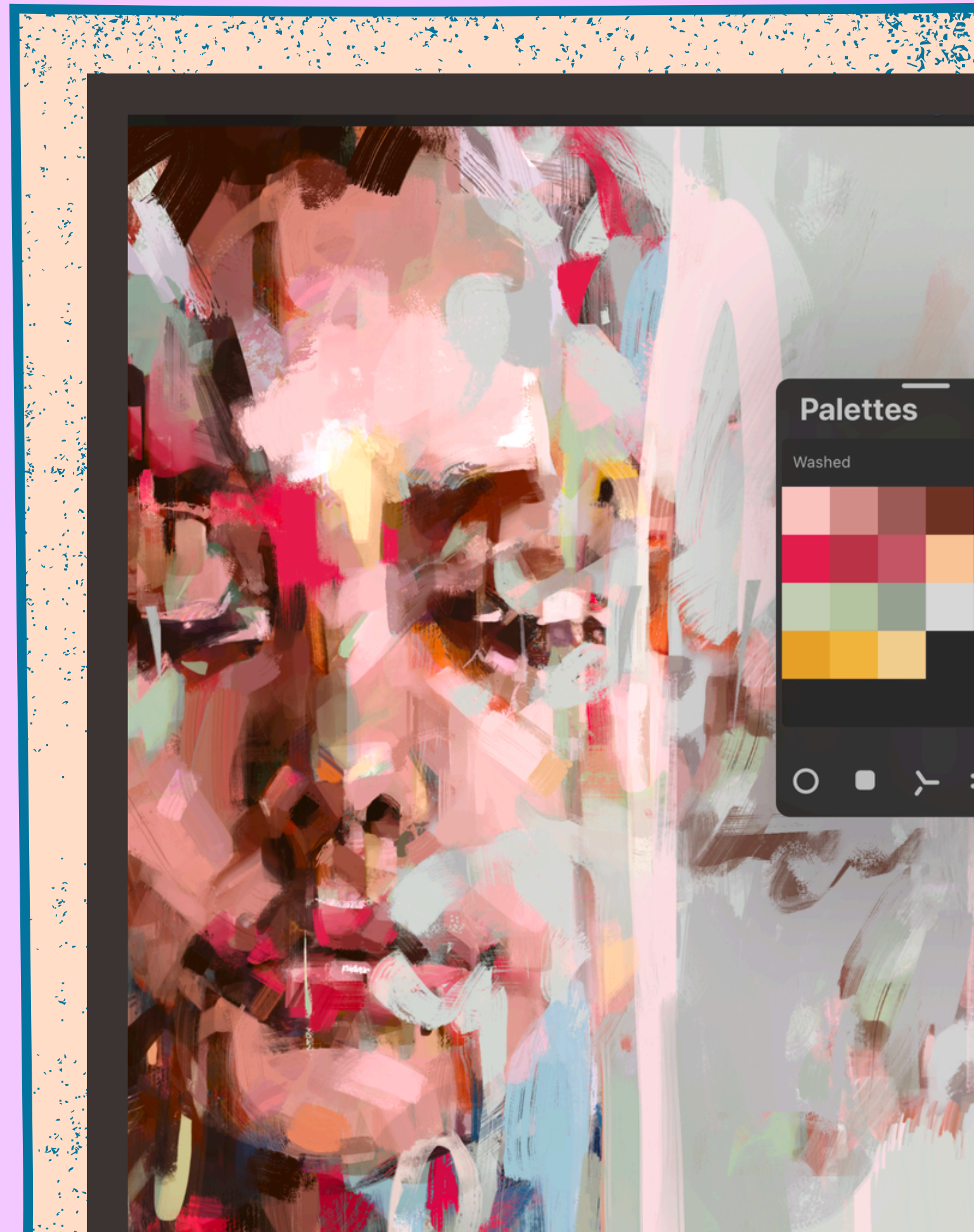
- Page Assist - Used to have multiple pages within the same document. Ex. Comic Panels, front and back to a poster
- Animation Assist - Provides an animation bar with settings for frame rate, onion skins, and type of animation

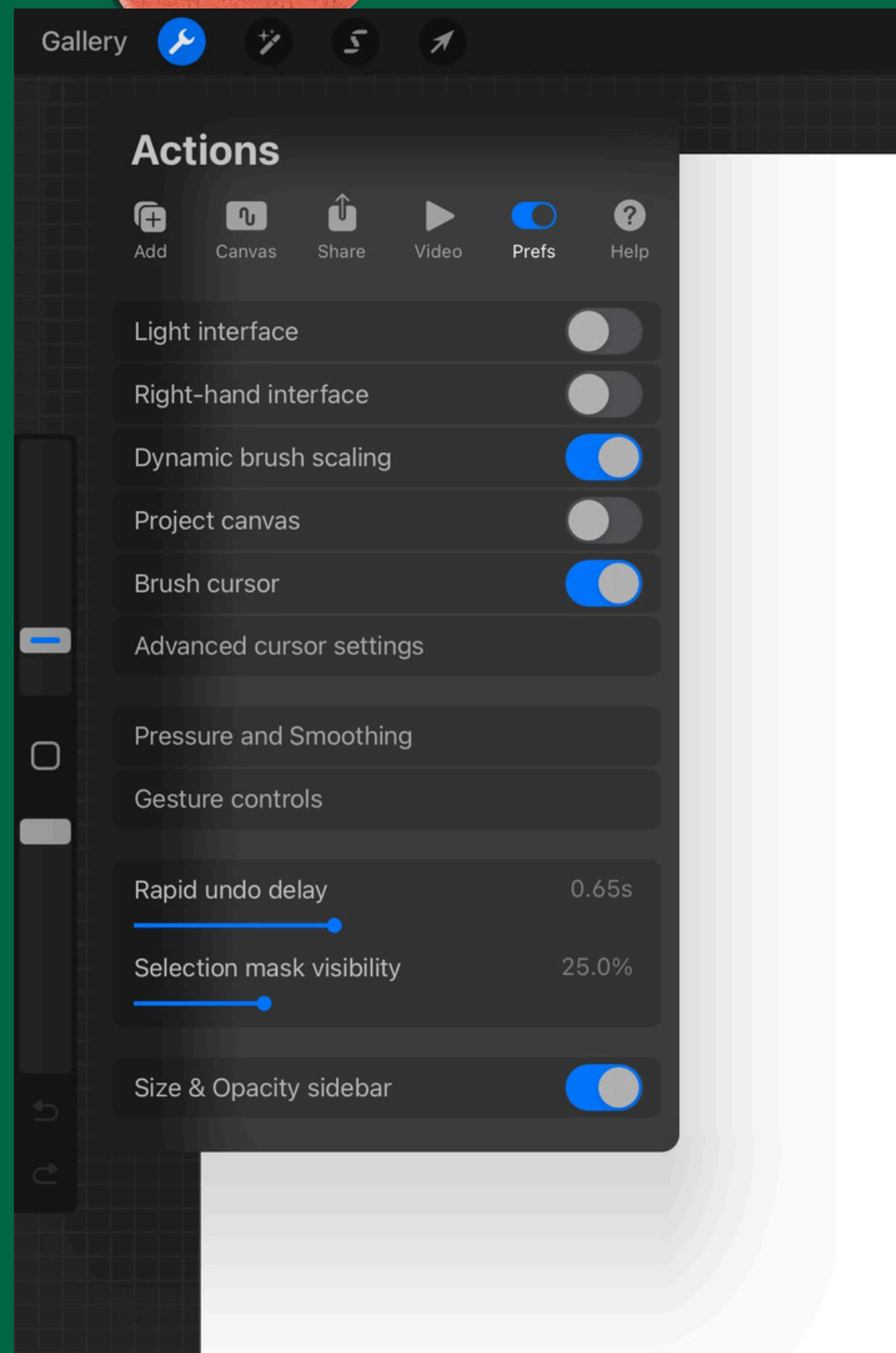

PREFERENCE OPTIONS

THERE ARE SEVERAL OPTIONS TO PERSONALIZE YOUR INTERFACE AND MAKE USING THE PROGRAM EASIER.

IF YOU ARE LEFT HANDED YOU CAN SWITCH THE BRUSH SIZE TOOLBAR TO THE LEFT, OR ENABLE THE CURSOR THAT TELLS YOU WHAT SIZE YOUR BRUSH IS AT AS YOU WORK.

MOST ICONS ARE SELF EXPLANATORY, BUT IF YOU ARE LOOKING FOR MORE SPECIFIC SETTINGS SELECT "ADVANCED CURSOR SETTINGS" TO CHANGE THE LOOK OF YOUR CURSOR IF ENABLED, THE PRESSURE SETTINGS OF YOUR APPLE PENCIL, OR THE GESTURES (SEE NEXT SLIDE) ENABLED IN THE PROGRAM
